

PARENT INFORMATION PRE-K TO KG 2



Classroom/ Individual Learning Space Set Up

As per the data received by the survey conducted, classrooms with capacity of maximum 10 students are arranged.

Each child will sit at individual tables placed 1.5m apart, from other children.

Students will store their bags under their individual tables when they enter the room. The cubbies in class will not be used, to avoid unnecessary congestion.

Students should bring enough water for the day as water dispensers have been removed for safety purpose.

Send a packed lunch and small, dry snacks for break time along with wet-wipes and a 50ml bottle of hand sanitizer in the school bag, every day.

Students will carry their stationery, listed below every day.

Teaching

The teacher will wear a head-microphone while teaching, so that the children who are remote learning are able to hear her during the lesson. The teachers will share their teaching screen with students onsite as well as offsite. Children will submit their work via Classkick and Phoenix. The teacher will provide online feedback and next steps to support each child's development.

Resource kit based on the timetable and activities

Please send the below common items for every day use:

- a box of crayons
- A4 paper (coloured and white),
- A4 size whiteboard or 2 laminated A4 sheets, 1 wiper & 1 black whiteboard marker,
- Playdough in a Ziploc bag, an extra set of clothes in a clearly labelled plastic cover, disposable gloves, masks, toilet seat covers
 (optional), table napkin, disposable cutlery.

If you have already purchased some stationary, these can be used. However, no item will be stored in school.

Devices

No devices should be brought to school. You will be informed when to send the device with your child.

Break/Lunchtime

The children will eat their snacks in the classroom. Their areas where they will eat will be sanitized before and after they eat.

Co-curricular Teaching

Music, Dance and Art lessons will take place in the classroom. Videos will be shared for the students who are attending online.

PE lessons will take place outdoors, in a shaded area. Students will participate in activities and teachers will ensure that they are socially distanced by 1.5m, while avoiding contact with each other.

Uniform

Labelled books and other resources will not be shared by any one else. Students will store their bags under their individual tables when they enter the room. The cubbies in class will not be used, to avoid unnecessary congestion.

Students should bring enough water for the day as water dispensers have been removed for safety purpose. Send a packed lunch and small, dry snacks for break time along with wet-wipes and a 50ml bottle of hand sanitizer in the school bag, every day.

Devices
